Annals of Laboratory Medicine (Ann Lab Med, ISSN 2234-3806, eISSN 2234-3814), the official journal of the Korean Society of Laboratory Medicine, is published bimonthly in English. Ann Lab Med has an open-access policy and covers a broad range of laboratory medicine-related topics from diagnostic hematology, clinical chemistry, clinical microbiology, diagnostic immunology, transfusion medicine, diagnostic genetics, laboratory informatics, to general laboratory medicine. Considering the pivotal role of laboratory tests in modern clinical practice, high-quality scientific papers dealing with diagnostic, therapeutic, prognostic, and translational researches are all within the scope of Ann Lab Med. Since being indexed in Medline/PubMed/Index Medicus in November 2007 and Science citation Index Expanded (SCIE, SciSearch) in April 2008, Ann Lab Med has broadened its readership and increased its leadership year by year. With the most recent JCR impact factor of 2.174 in 2016, Ann Lab Med is now preparing for another quantum leap that would be achieved by the great contribution of all authors, reviewers, and readers.
